Directions from Ferihegy International Airport (Budapest) to the City Centre:

If you arrive at Ferihegy International Airport you can choose from the following possibilities to get from the Airport (Terminal 1 or Terminal 2) to the centre of Budapest, where Central European University is located:

*** Shuttle service called the 'Airport Minibus'.**

Passengers are taken to the requested address by minibuses with eight to eleven seats. Tickets can be purchased at the Airport Minibus counter in the arrival-level passenger hall of Ferihegy Airport 1 and 2. The Airport Minibus counters are open between 05.00 a.m. and 01.00 a.m. at the Terminals.

Fare: one way ticket: 2990 HUF (approx.12 EUR.-/person), return ticket: 4990 HUF (approx. 19 EUR.-/person.) **Phone No.:** (+361) 296-8555.

*** Taxi:**

The airport taxi company is called Zóna taxi. They have fixed rates according to zones within the city. The maximum fare is approx. 25 EUR. Taxis are not equipped with credit card readers and might accept only Hungarian Forints (currency can be changed at the airport).

*** Public Transportation:**

Take Bus # 200 to Köbánya-Kispest (last stop), then the blue Metro Line to Deák tér. The Central European University is located at 5 minutes walk from from Deák tér.

If you plan to take the public transportation, you will have to buy tickets, which you can find in the Airport press kiosks.

A ticket must be validated immediately after boarding every time you enter a new vehicle, as well as at the entrance of metro stations. In Budapest tickets are transferable ONLY between metro lines.

If you arrive late in the night it is better to take the shuttle service or a taxi.
